If you have a project you would like considered by the Coccoloba Chapter of the Florida Native Plant Society, please present your proposal to one of the Board members listed below. The Board of Directors will review the proposal and will present it to the full membership, with a recommendation. Once a project is approved, invoices must be presented to the Treasurer for payment. The following must be completed before the proposal can be processed:

PROJECT: Please describe the project thoroughly. Include the size of the space and a brief landscape plan.

APPROXIMATE COST: Will this grant request complete the project? Are there any matching funds?

LOCATION: Describe the location. Is this a public or private space?

PURPOSE: Is this a butterfly garden, wildlife habitat, etc. Approximately how many people will visit this site? Who will they be (students, members of an organization, the general public)?

MAINTENANCE: Describe your maintenance plan. Who will be responsible for maintenance? Who will do the actual maintenance? How long will this project site be maintained?

VOLUNTEER HOURS REQUIRED: Describe the volunteer hours required to plan, plant and maintain the project site.
